Covid-19 New Variant

I have been asked to distribute information regarding the spread of the new Covid-19 variant (known as the Indian variant). This strain of the disease seems to be accounting for over 3/4 of cases in England and spreads more easily than the original strain. Hounslow is currently experiencing a 'surge' with more cases than any other borough in London. The council issued the following statement this week:

We are committed to updating you with the very latest information on Surge Testing and Vaccinations in the borough. Here is some new information for you to share please.

- Surge testing and increased vaccination continues in Hounslow to help tackle a new COVID-19 variant of concern.
- We need everyone to play their part and to get PCR tested as soon as possible and to get vaccinated when they can.

Anyone can get tested for free at the sites listed below, we have found that in school results are being returned within 24 hours.

Please be assured that we will continue to do everything we can to keep all safe and will react to any symptoms in either children or staff promptly to ensure that we limit any spreading of the disease.
