Annual Reviews

We are required to hold a meeting to review the outcomes and provision on your child's Educational Health Care Plan at least once a year. These annual review meetings will continue to be held over the telephone or using Zoom or Microsoft Teams for the duration of the autumn term. If you would prefer your child's annual review meeting to be conducted face to face in school, please contact the school office so we can arrange this.

You should receive a letter well in advance of the meeting informing you of the date and time it will be taking place. Please let us know as soon as possible if you need to change the date or time of your meeting so we can reschedule it at a time that suits you, as it is important you attend your child's annual review meeting.

Covid-19 Procedures

Whilst we have been advised to return to a more 'normal' way of operating in school we are still keeping certain things in place to help slow the spread of Covid-19. The school will implement the following procedures for the present time:

- Classes spread over three playgrounds at break
- Six classes will be eating lunch in their own classroom rather than going to the hall
- Children are still being encouraged to wash their hands regularly
- Classrooms continue to be well ventilated
- Children are distanced when queueing for lunch
