COVID-19 Update

Whilst all COVID-19 restrictions have now been lifted by the government, the virus is still in the community and there is a need to remain vigilant to continue to stop the spread. I have updated the school's risk assessment and the following will remain in place until further notice:

- If a child or adult at the school tests positive for COVID-19 then they will be asked to stay at home for five days initially. If they test negative on days five and six, or any two consecutive days after day five, then they can return to school.
- If the individual continues to test positive then we are following NHS guidance and insisting that they must stay away from school for ten days.
- Families are encouraged to test children twice a week at home with lateral flow tests.
- Keep your child at home and book a PCR test if your child shows any of the three main symptoms of COVID-19
- We would like parents and carers to continue to encourage good hand hygiene with children —
 washing and sanitising hands regularly
