The following children were voted to be captains and vice captains:

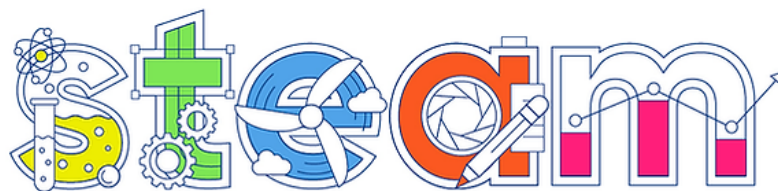
Farah — Dennis and Oliver

Holmes — Ollie and Joseph

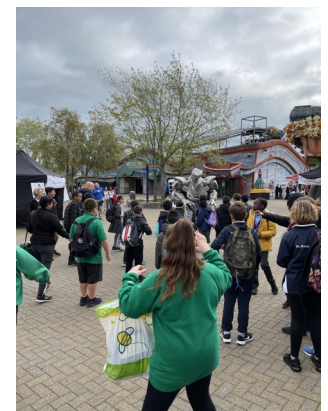
Mercury — Charlie and Muniir
